## Why do missionaries need so much prayer?

The apostle Paul, a man of deep prayer, begged believers to pray for him. He pleaded with the church, "I urge you, bretheren, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the Love of the spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God for me." (Romans 15:30) Like Paul, every mission worker needs prayer for their personal needs, for spiritual wisdom and power, for their family, and for the ministry to which they are called. The choice to serve, to go abroad, to leave family behind is not an easy one. They have chosen to go because the Lord has broken their heart over the things that matter, and they are consumed by the desire to see the Lost be found.

## How can you pray effectively?

First of all, be committed to them as a person. Seek to interact with them, and find out some of their key prayer needs. First, ask the Lord to show you how to pray for this missionary. Ask the person for details of their prayer needs. Pray for their personal needs. Pray for family needs. Pray for spiritual needs, and pray for their ministry needs.
